

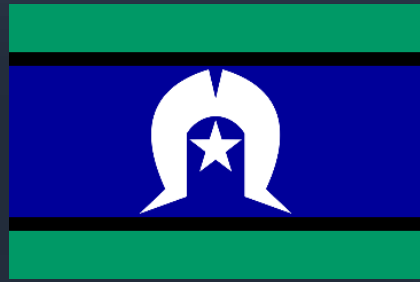

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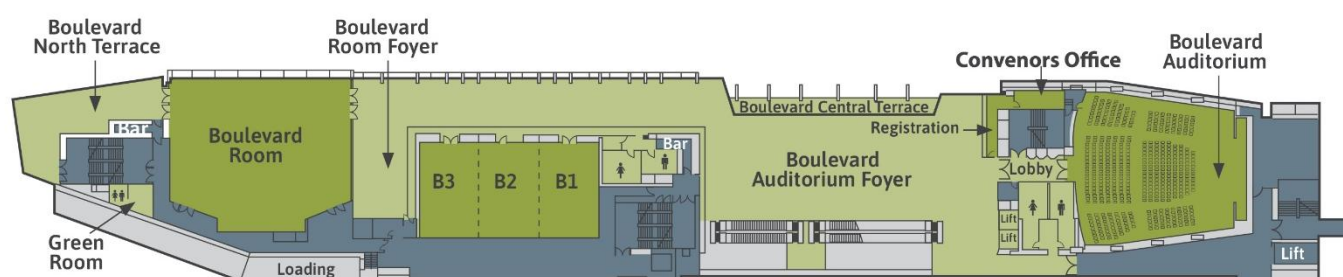

inspected, tested and tagged. Items that do not comply will not be permitted to be used onsite. Electrical items such as switchboards, cables and outlet fittings must comply with the Australian electrical wiring standard AS/NZS 3000:2007 and be installed by a qualified A grade electrician.

Note: Double adaptors will not be permitted on site, instead power boards with overload cut off are permitted. NOTE: The venue is at liberty to check that the electrical appliances you bring on site are appropriately tagged.
